### Musical Theatre Workshop

Grades 6–8	June 28–July 23		1:00–4:00	\$965

This four-week summer workshop will produce its own end-of-camp, one-act musical theatre production. The musical theatre workshop will focus on basic vocal technique, drama skills and choreography. The third and fourth week of camp consists of the process of writing the musical. The second week is focused on learning the music and lines, staging the production, and character development. The third week will be dedicated to the rehearsal and performance. The end-of-camp performance is on July 21 & 22 and is open to the public.

The camp workshop is skill-based, giving each student a unique opportunity to study the many aspects of the musical theatre experience. Our Conservatory musical theatre staff is interested in the development of the individual on a non-competitive basis. Values and respect are part of the experience, guided by care and support of our musical theatre staff.

### Summer Keys Piano Camp

Grades 1–3 <i>(beginners only)</i>	June 28–July 16	Session I	9:00–noon	\$745
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This three-week camp offers children the basics of piano in an engaging and social environment. Children will be introduced to listening skills and the fundamental elements of rhythm, melody, and notation. The camp progresses through a piano and theory method book over its course. Campers learn individual pieces with the instructor and participate in ensemble playing in the Yamaha keyboard lab. This is a great introduction to piano. The last day of camp includes a performance for parents and friends.

### Summer Keys Advanced Piano Camp

Grades 2–10 <i>(more experienced players with one or more year's private instruction)</i>	June 28–July 23		1:00–5:00	\$995
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This four-week piano camp offers students the opportunity to play duets, trios, and large group ensembles. The campers' schedule includes daily coachings, practice time, and group activities including music Jeopardy, arts & crafts, movies, music projects, listening, and appreciation. The camp culminates in a concert at the *Concordia Conservatory Summer Music Festival*.

### Beginning Guitar Camp

Grades 1–3 <i>(beginners only)</i>	June 28–July 16	Session I	9:00–noon	\$745
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What a great way to begin learning the guitar! In this group camp, campers take part in learning simple melodies and chords and develop basic guitar technique. The last day of camp includes a performance for parents and friends.

## Guitar Jam Camp

Grades 2–8      June 28–July 23      1:00–5:00      \$995  
(one or more year's private instruction)

Students at Guitar Camp have the opportunity to play guitar in a variety of styles, from rock power chords and folk strumming to jazz/blues “comping” and classical style. Participants will enjoy activities including playing in bands, lead-guitar soloing, improvisation, rhythm, guitar history, music reading, composition and theory as well as music games and recreation. Supportive teachers and classmates make this a camp for both beginners as well as more experienced musicians. The camp culminates in a concert at the *Concordia Conservatory Summer Music Festival*.

## Chamber Music Camp

Grades 2–12      June 28–July 23      9:00–noon      \$965

Chamber music provides students with the opportunity to enhance their performance skills, and expand their musical insight and awareness through coaching sessions. The faculty coach's role is to be a musical guidance counselor/facilitator.

The objective of the chamber music is to provide the students with knowledge and practice in the following areas:

- reading a musical score; analyzing and evaluating
- preparing the individual musical parts and learning non-verbal techniques of communication
- active learning and performing
- believing in yourself—every member of the group is important

The chamber music is for students in grades 2 – 12 who have had one or more years of private instruction. Chamber music participants will be grouped according to their skill level. Students exposed to the chamber music experience gain strength as individuals by means of group effort.... and Chamber Music is fun! The camp culminates in a concert at the *Concordia Conservatory Summer Music Festival*.

## Vocal Arts Workshop

Grades 6–12      June 28–July 23      1:00–5:00      \$995

The Vocal Arts Workshop is an immersive learning experience for middle and high school singers. This three-week program includes a bi-weekly private voice lessons with a faculty member, extensive performance opportunities, coaching sessions with pianists, audition technique classes, and master classes.

Working with a team of teacher/specialists, students explore the distinctive challenges of the musical theatre genre and classical song repertoire through survey work with songs, characterizations, vocal work, games, Alexander technique, and stage movement.

Open to singers and experienced pianists. The camp culminates in a concert at the *Concordia Conservatory Summer Music Festival*.

## Conservatory Summer Music Festival 2010

This concert is open to the public and spotlights the guitar, piano, chamber music, voice, and musical theatre camps in performance.

## Private Instruction for All Ages

June 28–August 6

Concordia Conservatory offers private lessons for a six-week session in piano, voice, guitar (acoustic, bass and electric), violin, viola, cello, bass, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, and saxophone. Lessons will be 30, 45, or 60 minutes in length and are open to children and adults. Students can register for as few as one or as many as six lessons. Due to this shorter commitment, the summer private instruction is an ideal time for students new to the Conservatory or for a current student to enjoy music instruction throughout the summer.

An interview is required for first-time students to determine teacher placement. When scheduling, if a mutually convenient lesson time and day cannot be agreed upon, the lesson fees will be fully refunded. Lessons will start being scheduled the first week of June. Students are scheduled in the order of receipt of their registration form and payment in the Conservatory office.
